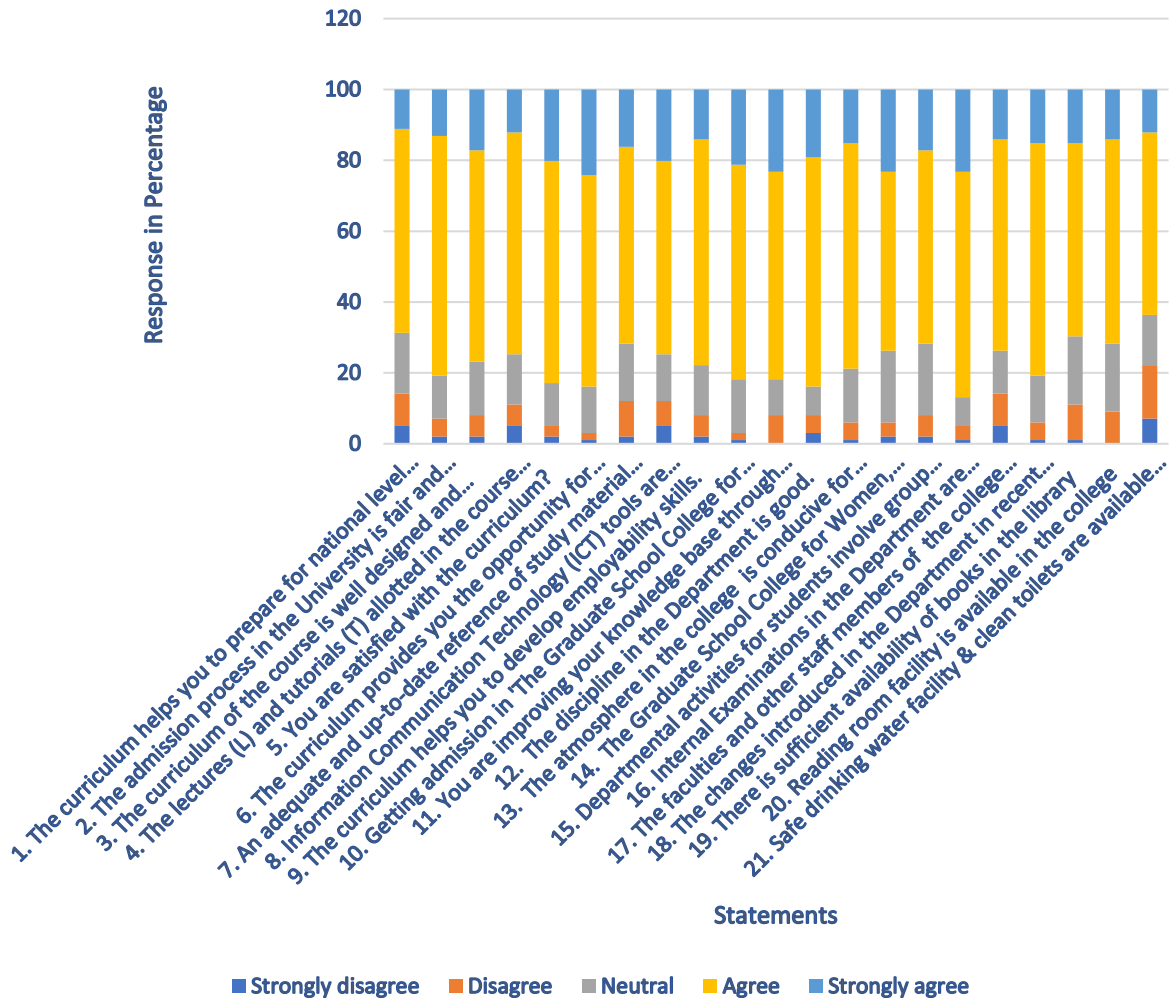
Results and Details of Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) on overall institutional performance:

1. As per the student survey analysis most of the students are found to improve their knowledge base through regular interaction with the faculties of the Department. To a moderate extent their mentoring has contributed towards their professional growth and generating their awareness towards the existing and upcoming career options.
2. Most of the students find that the curriculum is well designed thus promoting better learning experience and helping them to prepare for national level examination.
3. Since this batch of students witnessed the COVID-19 period, therefore, both mentor and students were involved in the application of ICT tools for conducting and attending virtual classes respectively. Appreciable efforts were made to maximise the use of presentation tools, virtual classroom platforms, video creation and editing tools, online assessment tools and other means for better communication with the students. However, during this period, group discussions, workshop, poster presentation etc. on non-virtual mode lacked due to the constraints posed due to COVID-19. Further, the students as well as institution identified the need for better computer labs and extended digital infrastructure for matching the future needs.
4. Most of the students find that lectures and tutorials allotted in the course are adequate. The teachers identify slow learners and conduct counselling and internal assessment specially for them.
5. From the questionnaire it appears that the student-teacher relationship is healthy as most of the regular students don't hesitate in interacting with their mentors and clearing their doubts.
6. The students find library staff cooperative and helpful. However, they are found to attach more expectations for improvement towards digital library facilities.
7. Most of the student has agreed with the cleanliness and well-maintained classrooms, toilets and overall campus.
8. The students agreed that the college staff members both academic and administrative attempt to resolve their problems on time.

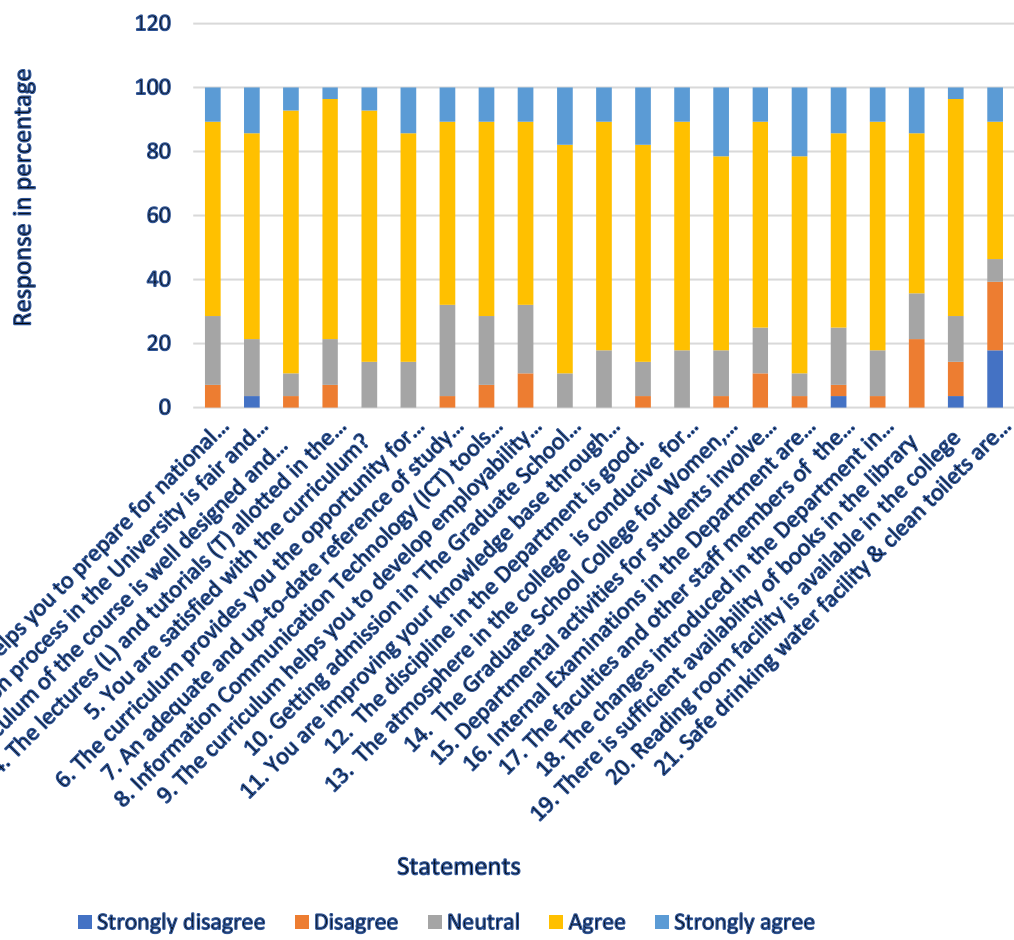

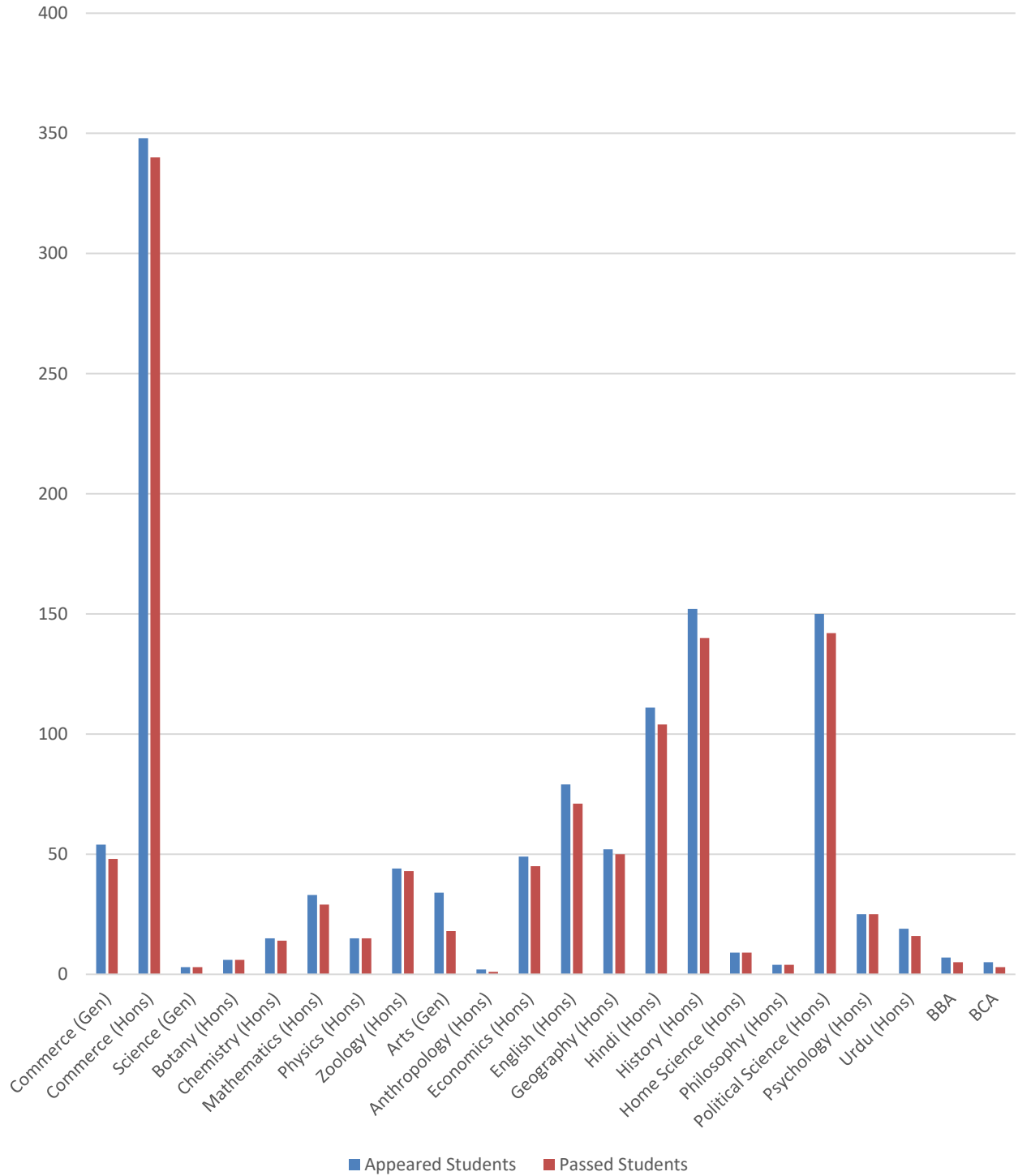
Feedback Analysis of Undergraduates (2021-2024), G.S.C.W based on 5-point Likert's Scale



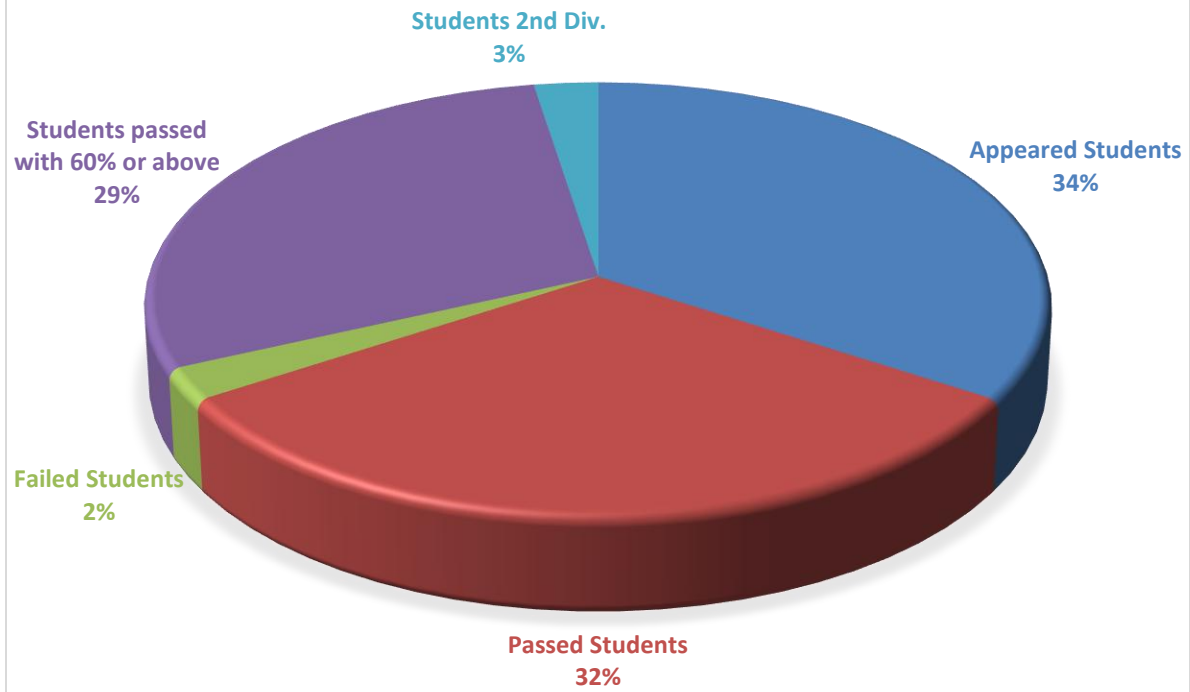
Feedback Analysis of Post Graduates (2022-2024), G.S.C.W based on 5-point Likert's scale



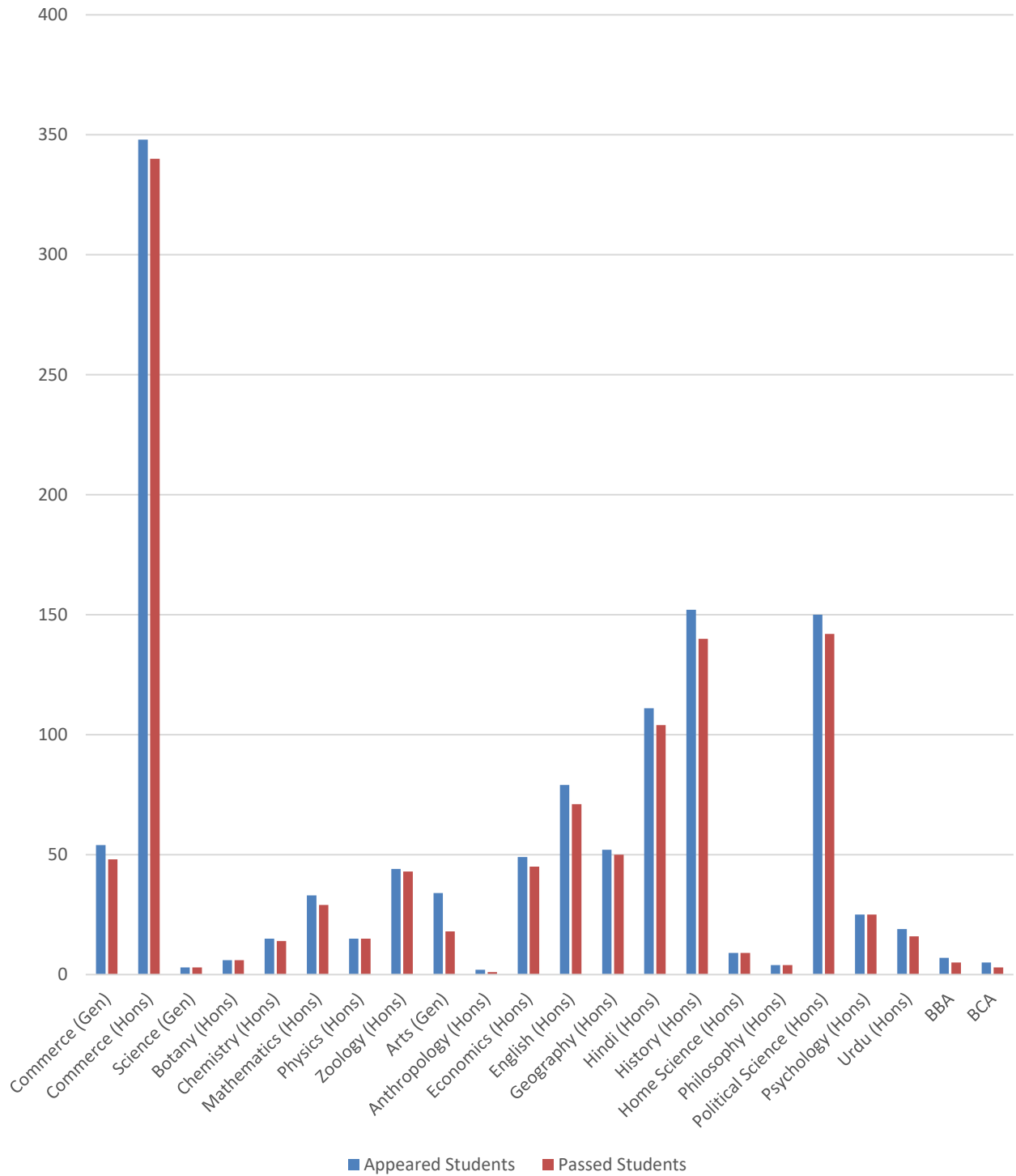
Student passed and appeared in the UG Final Year Examination 2021



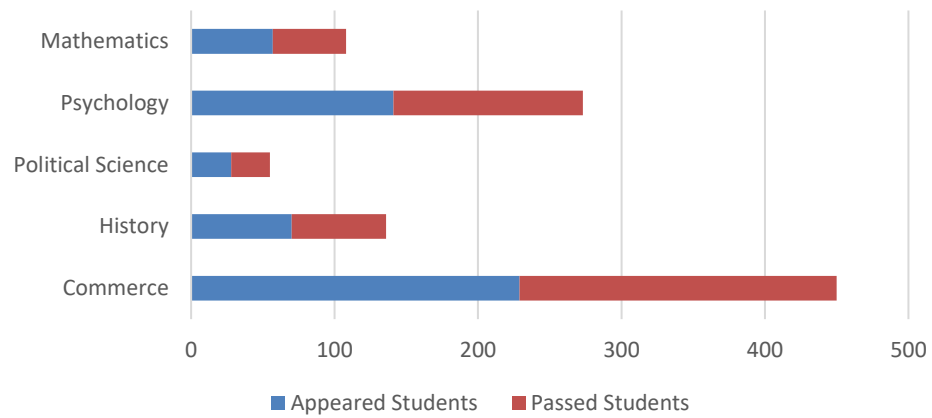
EXAMINATION RESULT UG 2021
